My role on the decision-making processes about Volunteering in my city-the workshop started with the brainstorming between the participants related with the volunteering opportunities in their countries/ local community, what are the opportunities of active involvement in the decision processes in their local community; after the first stage the participants were split in mixt groups and worked together to develop the strategy of ideal volunteering opportunities for young people that should exist in a community.

On the first day, there were workshops on decision-making procedures for young volunteering in the cities of participants, as well as introductions and presentations by partner organizations. A thorough session on encouraging adolescent volunteering in European local communities was held on the second day. It covered a wide range of topics, from context awareness to efficient volunteer administration. The participants' experience was enhanced by cultural excursions to Târgu-Jiu, which included a guided tour and a visit to the Village Museum Curtișoara and Chocolate Factory. On the last day, there was an open discussion about citizen engagement in local government, visits, and a management meeting to talk about the project's development, dissemination, and next steps.
