In this activity participants take on roles and move forward depending on their chances and opportunities in life. Participants impersonated a chosen character to reflect on equality and situations that elderly people faced during Covid-19. Some examples of characters: "You were the local bank manager. You have now a good retirement pension." "You are an elderly Chinese immigrant who, before retirement, run a successful fast food business." "You are a 65 farmer in a remote village in the mountains, who no longer has much strength to work." "You are a retired American ambassador to the country where you are living." "You are a 66 year-old man with Alzheimer who's unable to cover for elderly care." "You are a homeless old man, 67 years old.". Some example of statements: You have never encountered any serious financial difficulty. You know where to turn for advice and help if you need it. Other people consult you about different issues. Since the start of Covid-19 you could have a full understanding of the world health and pandemic situation. You know you can fully trust the health system and accept and follow the rules coming from the government. You had easy and quick access to Covid-19 vaccines. During Covid-19 you did not lose any people around you. Conclusions were that people who could step ahead did not look back to support others, and that this exercise does reflect the society in which we live.
