February 6th, 2024

Arrival of participants in Altea, Spain

February 7th, 2024

9:00 Gathering of participants at venue and registration of participants.

9:30 Welcome Speech from Diego Zaragozí, Mayor of Municipality of Altea and Germán Manjón, Councillor for European Projects. Presentation of the agenda and activities.

10:15 Thematic workshop and open discussion: "Spread the word" with European experts: This thematic workshop was designed as a round table, moderated by Ana Alonso - Head of Europa Direct – Valencian Community, in Alicante, who started with a brilliant speech and introducing the other speakers. The first one was Alberto Lorente, expert in European mobility and cooperation, talking about mobility and European cooperation with a presentation about pathways to integration and development. Secondly, itw as the turn of Carles Arques, European projects expert with a master in European Union Studies. Nowadays, he is the President of the Union of European Federalist for the Valencian Community (Spain). His speech was regarding institutions and political system of the European Union, explaining about its structure and functioning. Finally, the last speaker was Ángel Jesús Pérez, 2030 Agenda Coordinator and professor of UNED Denia and Environmentalist, who talked about activism in Modern Age, especially the different strategies and challenges. Aftert that, Ana Alonso opened a question session in which the audience ask about different topics to the speakers.

12:00 Seminar/ workshop on ESC volunteering and Erasmus+ mobilities; types of youth programmes: This seminar was designed as a round table, moderated by Paloma Verdú, manager of EuroAltea, the European Projects Office of the Municipality of Altea. She presented the activity and introduced the speakers. The first one was Germán Manjón, Councillor of European Projects of the Municipality of Altea, who explained the Municipal experience participating in European Projects since the European Projects Office is working. He was followed by Albert Llorens, health worker who was representing the volunteer population of Altea. Albert is volunteer in Red Cross Altea and he has been working in Volunteu during these 2 years, explaining his experience from the Red Cross to the audience. The following speaker was Luigi Balacco, founding member and director of the Association InCo Molfetta, partner of Volunteu project. His speech was through the practical vision of the future of European Solidarity Corps. Fourth speaker was Ignacio González, director of the DeAmiticia Association, who was presenting ECS (European Solidarity Corps) practical case study in AFCS (Volunteering Teams High Priority Areas) project. Following with Volunteu partnership, Kyriakos Kareklas, Mayor of the

Municipality of Athienou, Cyprus, made a speech about the political representation of Cyprus in the European context, emphasizing its experiencies and good practices as a Municipality. Finally, itw as the turn of Javier Expósito, director of ASEID (Association for Employment, Inclusion and Development) and expert in business partnerships in European projects.
